### **PRESS RELEASE FOR JANUARY 22, 2015**

#### **Assault**

On January 7, 2015 at 13:51 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a residence in the 500 block of Cherry Road for a disturbance. Investigation determined a resident thereat was struck in the face during an argument by a Jared Austin Mahoney, 24, also from the 500 block of Cherry Road, Souderton, PA. Mahoney was charged with Simple Assault and Harassment.

#### **Theft and Related**

On January 6, 2015 at 09:07 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Wawa located in the 3500 block of Bethlehem Pike for an employee related theft. Investigation determined that the employee, identified as Daniel James Falencki, 20, from the 100 block of Washington, Avenue, Souderton, PA had taken approximately \$500.00 in cash from the register. When questioned Falencki admitted to taking the money for medical and court payments. Falencki was charged with Theft by Unlawful Taking.

#### **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Controlled Substance**

On November 16, 2014 at 20:27 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Telegraph Road at Callowhill Road for erratic driving. The driver was identified as Jorge Santiago, 48, from the 100 block of Green Street Sellersville, PA. Santiago displayed indications of controlled substance impairment, and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Santiago was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed that he was driving under the combination of alcohol and controlled substance. Santiago was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance.

On December 6, 2014 at 0209 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Rt. 113 at Moyer Road for slow speed erratic driving. The driver was identified as Anthony Francis Kripp, 31, from the 400 block of Deep Run Road, Perkasio, PA. Kripp displayed indications of alcohol and controlled substance impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Kripp was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.099% BAC, and the presence of controlled substance. Kripp was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, and Roadways Laned for Traffic.

On October 19, 2014 at 13:22 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 600 block of Middle Road for the report of a single vehicle crashed into a tree. Investigation determined the vehicle was driven by Elvis Rolando Casasola-Leonardo. Casasola-Leonardo displayed indications of alcohol impairment, was placed under arrest, and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.268 % BAC. Casasola-Leonardo was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Drivers Required to be Licensed, and Careless Driving.

On December 26, 2015 at 23:12 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 800 block of Rt. 113 for a single vehicle crash. Investigation determined a vehicle, driven by David J. Ferrier, 58, from the 800 block of Wynnfield Drive, Souderton, PA, had driven off the roadway and struck a utility pole. Ferrier displayed indications of alcohol impairment. Ferrier was transported to Temple University Hospital where a sample of his blood was obtained which later revealed a 0.176% BAC. Ferrier was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Careless Driving.
