Hit and Run

On January 14, 2015 at 08:00 hours, Hilltown police responded to the intersection of Callowhill Road, and Broad Street for a two-vehicle hit and run crash. Police were advised the fleeing vehicle described as a Chevrolet Impala fled at a high rate of speed, passing through stop signs, and passing other uninvolved vehicles in no-passing zones. Witnesses further reported the Chevrolet Impala being occupied by a female passenger and infant at the time of impact. A vehicle description was flashed over police radio. The vehicle was stopped approximately 25 minutes later by Hatfield Township Police on Maple Avenue in Hatfield Township. Debris found at the crash scene matched the missing and damaged parts from the Impala. The driver of the Chevrolet Impala was identified as Antonio Rivera, 30, from the 100 block of South Maple Avenue, Hatfield, PA. Rivera was charged with Misdemeanor Endangering Welfare of Children, Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Vehicle, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, Duties at Stop Signs, No-Passing Zones, and Operation Following Suspension of Vehicle Registration.

Terroristic Threats

On January 12, 2015 at 11:10 hours, Hilltown Police met with a female complainant at headquarters who reported repeated and ongoing harassment and threatening communication beginning on January 2, 2015 by a subject identified as Terry Lee Bolton, 37, from the 1700 block of Redwood Court, Allentown, PA. Police viewed the text messages and contacted Bolton and warned him to cease all contact with the victim. Bolton advised Police that he would not stop in his communication. On January 30, 2015, the victim again met with Hilltown Police and reported that Bolton had continued to harass and threaten her on Facebook since being warned. Bolton further stalked the victim as she visited family members in Perkasio and Quakertown. Hilltown Police obtained an arrest warrant for Bolton for Terroristic Threats, Stalking to Cause Emotional Stress, and Harassment by Communication. Bolton was subsequently arrested by South Whitehall Police, arraigned before District Magistrate Patricia Engler, and Committed to Lehigh County Prison in lieu of \$250,000.00 bail.

Simple Assault

On February 1, 2015 at 12:28 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a domestic disturbance in the 200 block of Washington Place. Investigation determined that a resident, identified as Evan Frame, 37, had assaulted a female during a domestic argument. Frame was charged with Simple Assault and Harassment.

Theft and Related

On December 04, 2014 at 11:20 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Giant Food store, 760 Rt. 113 for a retail theft. Investigation determined that two male subjects had taken a shopping cart containing 24 4-packs of Red Bull past all points of retail sales and exited the store. The theft was valued in excess of \$220.00. Store video surveillance depicted two males working together during the theft of the merchandise. One subject, identified at that time as being Gregory Samuel Myers, 33, from the 2500 block of Peachtree Drive, Perkasio, PA, was charged for Retail Theft, Criminal Conspiracy, and Receiving Stolen Property. The second subject was later identified as William Morris Allen, 50, from the 300 block of West Chestnut Street, Souderton, PA. Allen was charged with Criminal Conspiracy to Commit Retail Theft, and Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended.
