Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or a Controlled Substance

On January 30, 2015 at 1430 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the CVS pharmacy parking lot, 700 Rt. 113 for the report of a man lying next to a pick-up truck. Upon investigation Police identified the man as Jack Randall Freed, 55, from the 300 block of East Reliance Road, Telford, PA as the operator of the pick-up truck. Freed was assisted to his feet and was unable to stand unassisted. Freed displayed indications of alcohol impairment and was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.312% BAC. Freed was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On January 9, 2015 at 1614 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Central Avenue at the Route 309 overpass for a single vehicle that had crashed into a tree. The operator was identified as Joshua Samuel Bennett, 22, from the 100 block of Forrest Road, Perkasio, PA. Bennett displayed indications of controlled substance impairment and was transported to a hospital for treatment of his injuries. A blood test was taken which later revealed the presence of a controlled substance. Bennett was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, and Careless Driving.

On January 10, 2015 at 2015 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the intersection of Broad Street and Callowhill Road for a single vehicle accident. The operator was identified as Darian Marisa Botson, 19, from the 600 block of South Main Street, Perkasio, PA. Botson displayed indications of controlled substance impairment and was transported to a hospital for treatment of her injuries. A blood test was taken which later revealed the presence of several controlled substances. Botson was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, and Careless Driving.

Simple Assault and Harassment

On February 21, 2015 at 2159 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 100 block of Brighten Court for the report of a disturbance. Investigation determined that a resident thereat had struck another resident during an argument. The actor was identified as Terron Childs, 44, from the 100 block of Brighten Court, Perkasio, PA. Childs was placed under arrest and charged with Misdemeanor Simple Assault, and Harassment.
