Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol

On January 31, 2015 at 0116 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a single vehicle traffic accident in the 500 block of Dublin Road. Through investigation the operator of the vehicle was identified as Andrew Nicholas Dzurko, 27, from the 1300 block of Providence Lane, Hatfield, PA. Dzurko displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Dzurko was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.166% BAC. Dzurko was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

Theft and Related

On January 23, 2015 at 1553 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 15154 Bethlehem Pike for a report of a retail theft. Investigation determined that on January 18, 2015 a female patron entered the store pushing an empty shopping cart. The female then placed two large items into the cart and exited past all points of retail sales through a closed lane. The female then exited the store and summoned another female. Both females then re-enter the store and proceeded to the customer service counter and returned the stolen merchandise. Both females were subsequently identified as Dawn Nichole Smalley, 39, from the 1900 block of 74th Street, Philadelphia, PA, and Keyana Person, 24, from the 7600 block of Washington Lane, Elkins Park, PA. Investigation further determined that Smalley had numerous prior arrests for retail theft, and as a result was charged with Felony counts of Retail Theft, Criminal Conspiracy, Theft by Deception, and Receiving Stolen Property. Person was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, Criminal Conspiracy, Theft by Deception, and Receiving Stolen Property.

On January 30, 2015 at 1221 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Giant Food Store, 760 Rt. 113, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron entered the store and placed three Keurig Coffee Machines and other retail merchandise in a shopping cart. The female then exited the store past all points of retail sales and proceeded to a vehicle which was parked in the lot. The female patron was identified through investigation as Tracey Marie Turchi, 37, from the 100 block of Oak Grove Road, Ottsville, PA. Further investigation determined that Turchi had been arrested on several prior occasions for retail theft. Turchi was charged with Felony Retail Theft, and Receiving Stolen Property.

Statutory Sexual Assault

On March 10, 2015, Hilltown Police received a report of a possible sexual assault involving a 14 year old female victim. Investigation determined that between November 2014 and March 2015 a male identified as Adam Joseph Umstead, 21, had been temporarily boarding at a residence. Investigation determined that during this time, Umstead engaged in sexual activity with an underage female resident thereat. Umstead was arrested for Felony Statutory Sexual Assault, and Corruption of Minors, and video arraigned before Judge Joseph Falcone of Bensalem and committed to Bucks County Prison in lieu of posting 10% cash of \$100,000.00 bail.

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On February 13, 2015 at 10:42 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a suspicious vehicle on Green Street near Rickert Road. The driver was identified as Brent Taylor Maffin, 18, from the 200 block of Noble Street, Souderton, PA. Evidence of controlled substance was detected and subsequently seized from within the vehicle. Maffin was charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
