Retail Theft

On April 7, 2015 at 16:58 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a store patron had removed and concealed nearly \$400.00 in store merchandise in bags, passed all points of retail sales, and exited the store. A description and registration was obtained by security as the subject fled the parking lot. The identity of the patron was determined to be James Christopher Handschuh, 25, from the 100 block of Allison road, Horsham, PA. Handschuh was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, and Receiving Stolen Property.

On April 13, 2015 at 09:41 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined a store patron accompanied by a 1 year old child had concealed in excess of \$800.00 in store merchandise in her baby bag and passed all points of retail sales. She was stopped and identified as Tiffany Angelina Szabo, 31, from the 500 block of 3rd Street, East Greenville, PA. Szabo was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, Endangering the Welfare of Children, and Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On November 25, 2014 at 18:59 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a traffic accident in the 200 block of Rickert Road. Investigation determined that a pickup truck had failed to negotiate a curve, and impacted a tree. The operator was identified as Troy B. Myers, 26, from the 1800 block of Krapf Road, Perkiomenville, PA. Myers displayed indications of substance impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Myers was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed the presence of controlled substances. Myers was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, and Possession of a Controlled Substance.
