PRESS RELEASE FOR MAY 19, 2015

Simple Assault

On April 19, 2015 at 11:30 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Grandview Hospital for the report of an assault which occurred on the 100 block of East Park Avenue, Silverdale PA. Investigation determined that a female had been punched in the eye by a male occupant residing at that residence. The male, David C. Davis, 56, was charged with Misdemeanor Simple Assault, and Harassment.

On May 09, 2015 at 17:59 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Rosewood Drive for the report of a disturbance. Investigation determined that a male resident identified as Louis Biase, 60, from the 100 block of Rosewood Drive, had pushed a female into a wall and threw bottles at her striking her in the leg area. Biase was taken into custody and charged with Simple Assault, and Harassment.

Driving Under the Influence

On March 18, 2015 at 0019 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 309 for speeding. The operator was identified as Jason Ryan Ferraro, 28, from the 100 block of Springfield Drive, Sellersville, PA. Ferraro displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Ferraro was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.11% BAC. Ferraro was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On December 28, 2014 at 2014 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the intersection of Park and Mill Roads for the report of a single vehicle crash involving an overturned vehicle. Investigation determined that the vehicle was driven by Daniel Johnson, 23, from the 1700 block of Diamond Street, Sellersville PA. Johnson displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Johnson was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.208 % BAC. Johnson was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Possession of a Controlled Substance.

On March 25, 2015 at 15:08 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a two vehicle crash at Barringer Avenue and Route 113 in Silverdale Borough. Investigation determined that a vehicle operated by a Lisa Filippi, 57, from the 100 block of Lawn Avenue, Sellersville, PA had impacted the rear of a vehicle that had stopped in a line of traffic. Filippi displayed indications of impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Filippi was placed under arrest and transported for a blood which later revealed numerous controlled substances in her system. Filippi was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Controlled Substances.

Retail Theft

On April 29, 2015 at 18:08 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation revealed that a store patron identified as Roseann M. Anderson, 34, from the 100 block of South 3rd Street, Perkasio, PA had concealed numerous store items in a bag and then passed through all points of retail sales. Anderson was subsequently stopped. Further investigation determined that Anderson had a prior retail theft conviction. Anderson was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.

On May 6, 2015 at 13:46 hours, Hilltown police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a store patron concealed numerous items inside her purse and passed all points of retail sales after paying for lesser items. The patron was identified as Sharon Louise Perott, 57, from the 400 block of South 5th Street, Perkasio, PA. Investigation further determined that Perott had two prior Retail Theft convictions. Perott was charged with Felony Retail Theft.

On May 8, 2015 at 15:10 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that two females had acted in concert by placing a television in a shopping cart, pushed the cart out of the store passed all points of retail sales and loading it into a pick-up truck. Both female actors were identified as Kieanna W. Caterisano, 22, from the 1900 block of Green Lane Road, Lansdale, PA and Christina Lynne Miller, 21, from the 100 block of North 2nd Street, North Wales, PA. Caterisano and Miller were both charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, Receiving Stolen Property, and Criminal Conspiracy.

Possession of Controlled Substance

On November 19, 2014 at 0945 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 100 block of Washington Court to assist Bucks County Adult Probation. While at the above location, Police met with an occupant identified as Scott Jarmon ,25. Jarmon had in his possession various controlled substances and was subsequently charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
