Theft and Related

On September 24, 2015 at 18:43 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a theft of a bicycle. Investigation determined that a store employee, identified as Juwaun J. C. Samuels, 21, from the 2000 block of Maple Avenue, Hatfield, PA, took a bicycle from the store without paying for it. He was charged with Theft by Deception.

On September 22, 2015 at 13:56 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a store patron, identified as Keith Curtis Olinick, 36, from the 100 block of Iroquois, Drive Royersford, PA, had cut numerous retail items, valued in excess of \$750.00, from their store packaging and left the store passing all points of retail sales. Olinick was charged with Misdemeanor Retail theft, and Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On August 09, 2015 at 20:22 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Bethlehem Pike near Schoolhouse Road for expired registration. The operator was identified as Marcel Anton Barfield, 20, from the 400 block of Allentown Road, Souderton, PA. Barfield displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Barfield was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.142% BAC in addition to a controlled substance. Barfield was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, Registration & Certificate of Title Required, Operation of Vehicle Without Official Certificate of Inspection, and Underage Consumption, Possession, or Transportation of Alcohol.

Hit and Run Attended

On September 30, 2015 at 07:26 hours, Hilltown Police responded to investigate a two-vehicle hit and run accident which occurred in the 1600 block of Hilltown Pike. A description of the operator, striking vehicle, and vehicle registration was obtained by witnesses. The operator of the vehicle was identified as Paul Kolodziejczak, 29, from the 100 block of Burnish Court, Perkasio, PA. Kolodziejczak was interviewed where he admitted to being the driver of the striking vehicle. Kolodziejczak was charged with Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Vehicle, and Overtaking Vehicle on the Left.
