Indecent Exposure

On October 8, 2015 at 00:35 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethehem Pike, for a report of a male who had parked next to a female store patron and was masturbating in his vehicle. The female patron reported when she walked past the actor, that he had no shirt, and his genitals were exposed. The female obtained a registration number and vehicle description. The vehicle was stopped by police a short distance away. The operator was identified as John Pickersgill, 52, from the 1300 block of Welsh Road, Lansdale, PA. Pickersgill was identified as the actor and charged with Indecent Exposure, and Open Lewdness.

Theft and Related Offenses

On August 29, 2015 at 11:23 hours, Hilltown Police was contacted by a vehicle dealership located on Route 309 which reported an employee had taken several business checks and without authorization deposited the funds into her personal bank account. Investigation determined the employee took over 12 checks over a 5 month period, totaling nearly \$7,000.00. The employee was identified as Janine Deemer, 42, from the 800 block of Callowhill Road, Perkasio, PA. Deemer was interviewed and confessed to taking the checks. Deemer was charged with Felony Theft By Unlawful Taking, and Forgery.

On September 2, 2015, Hilltown Police met with a resident who reported unauthorized access to and withdrawals from their bank account via their debit card on numerous occasions. Through investigation the actor was identified as David Bryan Kircher, 27, with no fixed place of residence. A warrant of arrest has been issued for Kircher for Felony Access Device Fraud, and Theft by Unlawful Taking.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On September 22, 2015 at 00:48 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 309 near Bergey Road for erratic driving. The operator of the vehicle was identified as Sarah Anne Morgan, 26, from the 100 block of South Main Street, Quakertown, PA. Morgan displayed indications of alcohol and controlled substance impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Morgan was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.143 % BAC, in addition to a controlled substance. Morgan was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, Driving on Roadways Laned for Traffic, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On August 26, 2015 at 00:14 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Wawa, 3520 Bethlehem Pike, for the report of a subject who was parked at the gas pumps and passed out behind the wheel of his running vehicle with his foot depressing the gas pedal racing the engine. The operator was identified as Jared Alexander Lyons, 19, from the 100 block of Centennial Road, Telford, PA. Lyons displayed indications of impairment due to controlled substance and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Lyons was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed the presence of several controlled substances. Lyons was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance.

On October 1, 2015 at 00:13 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Rickert Road, between Diamond and Green Streets, for erratic and reckless Driving. The operator was identified as Ernest M. Pelliccoitti, 19, from the 100 block of Aspen Drive, Sellersville, PA. Pelliccoitti displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. When the officer went to place Pelliccoitti under arrest, he immediately became combative and resisted arrest. Pelliccoitti was taken into custody and transported for a blood test to which he refused to submit. Pelliccoitti was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Resisting Arrest, Underage Consumption and Possession of Alcohol, and Driving on Right Side of Roadway.
