### **PRESS RELEASE FOR OCTOBER 20, 2015**

#### **Burglary and Related Offenses**

On August 30, 2015 at 02:02 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Romanowski field for the report of suspicious activity. The report advised that two males were observed walking around the field clubhouse and sounded as if they were attempting to break into the building. Upon Police arrival, the subjects fled on foot. Police discovered numerous items, including two cash registers, that were taken from the clubhouse and dropped by the fleeing suspects. Through investigation, Police identified the two suspects as Maxwell Scott Tuerke, 18, from the 700 block of South County Line Road, Telford, PA, and Antonio Dominic Juliano, 19, from the 2500 block of Three Mile Run Road, Perkasie, PA. Both suspects were interviewed and confessed to committing the burglary. They were charged with Burglary, Criminal Conspiracy, Possessing an Instrument of Crime, Theft By Unlawful Taking, and Criminal Mischief.

#### **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance.**

On July 11, 2015 at 16:30 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 113 at Route 309 for a littering violation. The operator was identified as James Francis Zahner, 29, from the 400 block of North Second Street, Telford, PA. Zahner displayed indications of controlled substance impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Zahner was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed the presence of several controlled substances, Zahner was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Controlled Substance.

On July 17, 2015 at 01:10 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle in the 900 block of Callowhill Road for a vehicle lighting violation. The operator was identified as Salvatore Cotteta, 32, from the 4000 block of Diane Way, Doylestown, PA. Cotteta displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Cotteta was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.134% BAC and the presence of controlled substance. Cotteta was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, and Use of Multiple Beam Road Lighting Equipment.

On September 19, 2015 at 17:06 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a single vehicle accident on Limekiln Pike at Azlen Lane. Investigation determined that the driver, Jennifer Frattone, 48, from the 100 block of East Wenger Avenue, Silverdale, PA, had lost control of her vehicle and overturned. Frattone displayed indications of alcohol impairment. Frattone was flown to Temple University Hospital where a blood sample was obtained. The blood test later determined a 0.19% BAC. Frattone was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

### **Retail Theft and Related Offenses**

On September 12, 2015 at 16:40 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female store patron, identified as Subarna Uddin, 31, from the 800 block of Wedgewood Drive Lansdale, PA, had concealed nearly \$450.00 in video games and exited the store without paying for them. Uddin was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.

On September 26, 2015 at 16:41 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male patron attempted to take merchandise from the store, and upon discovery, fled the store after physically engaging a store employee. The suspect was located on foot several blocks from the store, and identified as William Richmond Walter, 27, from the 2600 block of Anthony Drive, Colmar, PA. Walter was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, and Harassment.

### **Hit and Run Attended**

On September 30, 2015 at 07:26 hours, Hilltown Police met with the victim of a hit and run accident. The victim reported that his vehicle was struck by another vehicle and that the driver of the striking vehicle left the scene and failed to provide the required information. The operator of the striking vehicle was identified as Paul A. Kolodziejczak, 30, from the 100 block of Burnish Court, Perkasie, PA. Kolodziejczak was charged with Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Vehicle or Property, and Overtaking Vehicle on the Left.
