Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On September 16, 2015 at 14:25 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a two vehicle traffic accident on Route 113 at Landis Road. The investigation determined that one of the operators involved in the accident displayed indications of alcohol impairment. The operator was identified as Austin Dane Kimata, 32, from the 200 block of Route 152, Perkasio, PA. Kimata failed a series of field sobriety tests, was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.174% BAC. Kimata was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Careless Driving.

On September 2, 2015 at 18:06 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the report of a disturbance/road rage incident at the Hilltown Plaza Shopping Center involving a black Ford pickup truck. Police subsequently made contact with the vehicle and the operator. The operator was identified as Jeffrey Christopher Boston, 50, from the 4300 block of Bethlehem Pike Telford, PA. Boston displayed indications of alcohol impairment and refused field sobriety tests. Boston was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.209% BAC. Boston was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Disorderly Conduct. On October 1, 2015 at 19:47 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Wawa, 3520 Bethlehem Pike, for the report of a two-vehicle accident involving a black Ford pickup truck. Investigation determined that the pickup truck was again driven by Jeffrey Christopher Boston. Boston displayed indications of substantial alcohol impairment and again refused field sobriety tests. Boston was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.188% BAC. Boston was charged a second time for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Limitations on Backing.

Theft and Related Offenses

On September 13, 2015 at 20:08 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male store patron had removed numerous store items from store packaging and proceeded past all points of retail sales without paying for them. The patron was identified as Steven David Bidden, 32, from the 2300 block of Hieter Road, Quakertown, PA. Bidden was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On October 9, 2015 at 12:54 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male store patron had taken numerous retail items past all points of retail sales, and out of the store without paying for them. The patron initially provided false identification but was later identified as Michael Stephen Cervantes, 22, from the 100 block of Queen Circle, Chalfont, PA. Cervantes was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, and False Identification to Law Enforcement.
