PRESS RELEASE FOR DECEMBER 3, 2015

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Controlled Substance

On October 16, 2015 at 08:14 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the parking lot of the Wawa located at Routes 313 and 113 for a two vehicle traffic accident. Investigation determined that a female driver identified as Traci Lawler Coyne, 44, from the 500 block of Solliday Court, Perkasie, PA had struck two vehicles parked within the lot. Coyne displayed indications of controlled substance impairment. Coyle was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed the presence of several controlled substances. Coyne was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, and Careless Driving.

On October 20, 2015 at 22:43 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for the report of an unconscious driver behind the wheel of a running vehicle in the parking lot. Through investigation, the driver was identified as Avery James Hiller, 18, from the 100 block of Timberline Drive, Tafton, PA. Police further observed three cans of compressed gas dust containers located in the vehicle. Hiller displayed indications of substance impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Hiller was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed the presence of a controlled substance, and solvents contained within the compressed gas containers. Police further obtained surveillance video from Walmart security revealing that Hiller concealed the three cans of dust containers and removed them from the store without paying for them. Hiller was charged with Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Driving Under the Influence of a Solvent or Noxious Substance, and Retail Theft.

On October 20, 2015 at 02:07 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 309 near Route 113 for erratic driving. The driver was identified as Dalton O. M. Young, 55, from the 200 block of Scenic View Lane, Hellertown, PA. Young displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Young was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.172% BAC. Young was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Driving on Roadways Laned for Traffic.

On November 19, 2015 at 22:48 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a single vehicle traffic accident in the 3400 block of Bethlehem Pike. Investigation determined a single vehicle struck a utility pole. The driver was identified as Alexandra L. Bollinger, 23, from the 300 block of North 3rd Street, Telford, PA. Bollinger displayed indications of alcohol impairment and was transported to a hospital for treatment where a blood test was taken, resulting in a 0.211 % BAC. Bollinger was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

Trespass

On November 18, 2015 at 19:12 hours, Hilltown Police were summoned by Walmart Asset Protection personnel for trespass by a female patron. Nicole L. Crawford, 30, from the 2200 block of Upper Stump Road, Perkasio, PA was observed concealing retail items inside her pocketbook but abandoned the items after determining she was detected by store personnel and left the store. Crawford was previously issued a notice of restriction from Walmart barring her from returning to the property. Crawford was charged with Defiant Trespass by Actual Communication.

False Identification to Law Enforcement

On November 5, 2015 at 22:20 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a single vehicle accident on Route 309 at Reliance Road. Investigation determined a vehicle traveling southbound had lost control and impacted the center concrete barrier. A female had exited the car prior to Police arrival and reported that another female was driving the vehicle. The female provided a name and identifying information which was determined to be false. The female was eventually identified as Rebekah A. Urffer, 28, from the 200 block of Three Mile Run Road, Sellersville, PA. Urffer was charged with False Identification to Law Enforcement Authorities, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, and Careless Driving.

Theft and Related Offenses

On November 29, 2015 at 17:09 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Giant Food Store, 760 Route 113, for a retail theft. Investigation determined a female shopper selected over \$200.00 in store merchandise, passed all points of retail sales and left the store without paying for the items. The shopper was identified as Marysol Soto, 39, from the 100 block of Woodspring Circle, Sellersville, PA. Soto was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.
