Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On November 2, 2015 at 17:52 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 100 block of Brighten Court, Silverdale Borough for the report of a vehicle driving only on a tire rim. Police located the vehicle and identified the driver as Coleen Patricia Breslin, 29, from the 100 block of Hampshire Drive, Sellersville, PA. Breslin displayed indications of alcohol and controlled substance impairment. Breslin was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.09% BAC in addition to controlled substances. Breslin was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Driving Under the Influence of Controlled Substance.

On November 13, 2015 at 20:15 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle at Route 113 and Bethlehem Pike for a suspended registration. The driver was identified as Paul R. Seip, 32, from the 2400 block of Lomara Drive, Pottstown, PA. Seip displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Seip was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.112% BAC. Seip was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On November 08, 2015 at 03:06 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Wawa, 320 Route 313, for a subject sleeping behind the wheel. The operator was identified as David Dale Schumaker, 56, from the 500 block of Princess Avenue, Croydon, PA. Schumaker displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Schumaker was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.102% BAC. Schumaker was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On October 23, 2015 at 12:55 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Wawa, 3520 Bethlehem Pike, for a reported hit and run accident. Investigation determined that an operator involved in the two vehicle accident had fled the scene. The fleeing operator was identified as Jacob Aaron Butler, 42, from the 100 block of Palace Court, Chalfont, PA. Butler was located by Police at 14:34 hours. Butler displayed indications of alcohol impairment. He was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.312% BAC. Butler was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Vehicle or Property, and Careless Driving.

On November 22, 2015 at 00:39 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 500 block of Dublin Road for the report of a single vehicle traffic accident. Investigation determined a vehicle driven by Bruce Eric Wilson, 53, from the 1100 block of New Galena Road, Fountainville, PA had impacted a bridge. Wilson displayed indications of alcohol impairment and was transported to a hospital for injuries. A blood test was performed which later revealed a 0.243 % BAC. Wilson was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Careless Driving.

On November 7, 2015 at 23:25 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the area of Keystone Drive, near Route 113 for a driver passed out behind the wheel, and stopped on the roadway. Police identified the driver as Zachery Michael Warren, 22, from the 100 block of Keystone Drive, Sellersville, PA. Warren displayed indications of controlled substance impairment and was placed under arrest. Warren was transported for a blood test which later revealed the presence of several controlled substances. Warren was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Controlled Substance.

On November 30, 2015 at 13:40 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Bethlehem Pike near Central Avenue for high speed and reckless operation. The operator was identified as Zakery Nicholas Sundin, 20, from the 100 block of 3rd Street, Perkasie, PA. Sundin displayed indications of alcohol impairment, and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Sundin was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.156% BAC in addition to controlled substance. Sundin was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, Traffic Control Signals, and Underage Consumption and Possession of Alcohol.

On November 26, 2015 at 03:29 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on East Creamery Road, at Blooming Glen Road for erratic driving. The driver was identified as Shannon Marie Short, 28, from the 100 block of Vine Street, Perkasie, PA. Short displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Short was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.193% BAC. Short was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Duties at Stop Signs.

Theft and Related Offenses

On December 3, 2015 at 10:50 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Giant food store, 760 Route 113 for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron had taken numerous retail items past all points of retail sales and left the store without paying for them. The patron was identified as Marysol Soto, 39, from the 100 block of Woodspring Circle, Sellersville, PA. Soto was charged with Retail Theft, and Receiving Stolen Property.

Recklessly Endangering Another Person

On November 21, 2015 at 20:17 hours Hilltown Police responded to the area of the 100 block of Reliance Square for a disturbance involving a male subject driving a gray pickup truck. Prior to arrival, responding Police observed the vehicle traveling on Reliance Road at a high rate of speed in a reckless manner. Police stopped the vehicle at Bethlehem Pike and Schoolhouse Road. The driver was identified as Paul Raymond Force, 32, from the 600 block of South Perkasie Road, Perkasie, PA. Investigation determined that Force was the actor at the disturbance call and upon fleeing Reliance Road, nearly struck a security guard at that location. Force was charged with Recklessly Endangering Another Person, Harassment, Disorderly Conduct, and Careless Driving.
