Theft and Related Offenses

On January 20, 2016 at 16:10 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined a female patron, who was identified as Joann Lakeshia McKinnon, 57, from the 2400 block of Old Welsh Road, Willow Grove, PA, had taken an electronic item past all points of retail sales without paying for it and left the store. Investigation further determined that McKinnon had a prior arrest for Retail Theft. McKinnon was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Controlled Substance

On January 30, 2016 at 07:23 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Route 309 southbound at Central Avenue for a two-vehicle traffic accident. Investigation determined that a vehicle operated by Robert Jozefowski, 40, from the 1500 block of Schwab Road, Hatfield, PA had moved from the left lane into the right lane of travel and impacted another vehicle. Jozefowski displayed indications of alcohol impairment, and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Jozefowski was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.259% BAC. Jozefowski was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Careless Driving.

False Identification to Law Enforcement

On February 13, 2016 at 18:35 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. The actors fled the Walmart and a description was obtained. An actor fitting the description was located a short distance away at another retail establishment. The subject was advised he was the target of an official investigation and was requested to provide identification. The subject provided a false name and identification card. Police determined his true identity as being Thomas Coleman, 35, from the 6000 block of Race Street, Philadelphia, PA. Police further determined that active arrest warrants existed for Coleman from Delaware County. Coleman was taken into custody, charged with False Identification to Law Enforcement, and lodged in the Bucks County Correctional Facility on the outstanding warrant.
