Theft and Related Offenses

On February 8, 2016 at 17:16 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male and female patron had taken various retail items and concealed those items inside their outer clothing. They passed all points of retail sales and attempted to exit the store. The two were identified as Joseph Kroh, 27, from the 300 block of 9th Street, Sellersville, PA, and Heather Parker, 25, from the same address. Both Kroh and Parker were charged with misdemeanor retail theft, and criminal conspiracy.

On March 2, 2016 at 17:29 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron concealed retail items inside her purse and passed all points of retail sales without paying for the items. The female was identified as Kathleen Guckavan, 47, from the 100 block of Colmar Avenue, Colmar, PA. Guckaman was charged with Felony Retail Theft.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On February 13, 2016 at 04:03 hours, Hilltown Police observed a man passed out behind the wheel of his running vehicle parked at the Wawa, 3520 Bethlehem Pike, Souderton, PA. Police approached the driver and detected indications of intoxication. The operator was identified as Ryan Landis Lhedmat, 23, from the 100 block of Mill Bend Road, Levittown, PA. Lhedmat failed a series of field sobriety tests. He was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.176% BAC. Lhedmat was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.
