PRESS RELEASE FOR MAY 6, 2016

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and or Controlled Substance

On April 05, 2016 at 14:56 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 1400 block of Route 113 for a single vehicle traffic accident. Investigation determined that a vehicle traveled off the roadway and impacted a utility pole. The driver was identified as Sean Jarnutowski, 39, from the 2300 block of Schukraft Road, Quakertown, PA. Jarnutowski displayed indications of alcohol impairment and was transported to a hospital for treatment of his injuries. A blood test was performed which later determined Jarnutowski had a 0.229 % BAC. Jarnutowski was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On March 18, 2016 at 00:54 hours, Hilltown Police investigated a suspicious vehicle which was stopped and running behind the Burger King located at 730 Route 113. The driver was identified as Robert Morrell, 46, from the 100 block of Graceful Lane, Levittown, PA. Morrell displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Morrell was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which he refused. Morrell was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On April 11, 2016 at 01:44 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Mill Road at Park Road for high speed erratic driving. The driver was identified as Robert Charles Weimar, 26, from the 300 block of Mill Road, Hatfield, PA. Weimar displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Weimar was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.096% BAC in addition to the presence of a controlled substance. Weimar was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, and Driving Vehicle at Safe Speed.

Theft and Related Offenses

On April 24, 2016 at 17:15 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a store patron, identified as Zachary W. Shelly, 31, from the 700 block of Clemens Road, Telford, PA, had concealed retail items, passed all points of retail sales, and then returned the items for a Walmart gift card without ever having paid for the items in the first place. Shelly was charged with Misdemeanor Theft by Deception.

On May 2, 2016 at 1700 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male patron concealed automotive batteries inside a sweatshirt within a cart, and passed all points of retail sales without paying for the batteries. The patron was identified as Michael Williams Saunders, 35, from the 500 block of West Walnut Street, Perkaspie, PA. Saunders was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.

On April 28, 2016 at 16:00 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male patron had concealed nearly \$400.00 in store merchandise inside bags within a cart and passed all points of retail sales. When confronted by asset protection personnel the subject fled the store on foot. Through investigation, the patron was identified as Tyler Fitzgibbons, 32, from the 100 block of Water Crest Drive, Doylestown, PA. Fitzgibbons was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.
