PRESS RELEASE FOR JULY 29, 2016

Theft and Related Offenses

On July 24, 2016 at 17:48 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined a male patron attempted to push a loaded shopping cart loaded with automotive items out of a store exit without paying for the items. The patron was identified as Mohamed E. Ouddai, 28, from the 700 block of West Main Street, Lansdale, PA. Ouddai was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft.

Burglary and Related Offenses

On July 25, 2016 at 12:36 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a residential Burglary in Progress call in the 600 block of Orchard Road. Upon Police arrival, a subject was observed fleeing the rear of the residence into a heavy wooded area near Diamond Street. Police pursued the suspect on foot and apprehended him a short distance later. He was identified as Christopher W. Soriano, 29, from the 2100 block of Spinnerstown Road, Spinnerstown, PA. Soriano was charged with Burglary, Criminal Trespass, Criminal Mischief, and Theft by Unlawful Taking. Soriano was video arraigned before Judge Regina Armitage, and committed to Bucks County Correctional Facility in lieu of posting \$75,000.00, 10% bail.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On June 27, 2016 at 19:00 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the area of Washington Square and Conestoga Way for the report of an erratic driver. Police responded and located the vehicle and identified the driver as Crystal Marie Dzintars, 32, from the 200 block of Washington Square, Telford, PA. Dzintars displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Dzintars was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later indicated a 0.214% BAC and the presence of a controlled substance. Dzintars was charged with Driving Under Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, and Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended.

On July 3, 2016 at 01:02 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle at Route 152 and West Creamery Road for a speeding violation. The operator was identified as John Robert Shoffler, 23, from the 500 block of West Chestnut Street, Perkasio, PA. Shoffler displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Shoffler was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.12% BAC. Shoffler was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Maximum Speed Limits.
