Theft and Related Offenses

On September 8, 2016 at 18:45 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron selected over \$500.00 in various store merchandise and walked out of the store without paying for it. When store security personnel attempted to detain the female, she abandoned the merchandise and entered the passenger seat of a waiting and running vehicle. The vehicle registration was obtained as the male driver fled the lot. The male and female were identified as Kristina L. Campbell, 49, from the 200 block of West Market Street, Perkasie, PA, and Jesse Daniel Moyer, 19, from the 100 block of Anjou Court, Telford, PA. Campbell was charged with Retail Theft, and Criminal Conspiracy. Moyer was charged with Criminal Conspiracy, and Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended or Revoked.

Hit and Run

On September 18, 2016 at 19:38 hours, Hilltown Police were summoned to investigate a hit and run accident occurring on Bethlehem Pike at the Hilltown Crossing Shopping Center. After striking the victim's vehicle from behind, the striking vehicle fled the scene through the parking lot and then continued northbound on Bethlehem Pike into the Telford area. A description of the operator and vehicle registration was obtained. Police identified the driver as Thomas Wilson Cassel, 50, from the 400 block of East Reliance Road, Telford, PA. Cassel was charged with Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Vehicle or Property, Duty to Give Information and Render Aid, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended or Revoked, and Following Too Closely.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Controlled Substance

On August 27, 2016 at 22:06 hours, Hilltown Police arrived at the scene of a two vehicle traffic accident where a vehicle rear ended another vehicle which was stopped for a red traffic signal located at Route 113 and Bethlehem Pike. Upon investigation, the driver of the striking vehicle displayed indications of alcohol impairment. She was identified as Pamela J. Winder, 49, from the 400 block of Wicker Avenue, Bensalem, PA. Winder was transporting a toddler at the time of the accident. Winder failed a series of field sobriety tests. She was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.152% BAC. Winder was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Endangering the Welfare of Children, and Careless Driving.
