PRESS RELEASE FOR OCTOBER 31, 2016

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance

On October 04, 2016 at 22:18 hours, Hilltown police stopped a vehicle on Hilltown Pike near Route 152 for erratic driving. The operator was identified as Michael Haines, 53, from the 100 block of Allem Lane, Perkasio, PA. Haines displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a field sobriety test. Haines was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.150 % BAC. Haines was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Driving on Roadways Laned for Traffic.

On October 08, 2016 at 18:35 hours, Hilltown Police responded to a suspicious vehicle call in the Deerfield development. The vehicle was located and stopped on Route 113 near Telegraph Road. The operator was identified as Zachary Horger, 43, from the 1100 block of Slotter Road, Perkasio, PA. Horger displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Horger was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.175% BAC. Horger was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

Accidents Involving Personal Injury

On September 5, 2016 at 17:56 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Route 309 at the Hilltown Crossing Shopping Center for a two vehicle Hit and Run accident involving injuries. A vehicle had struck a stopped vehicle and then the striking vehicle fled northbound on Route 309. Through investigation, the driver was identified as Wellington Maurice Evans, 25, from the 2800 block of West 4th Street, Wilmington, Delaware. Evans was subsequently charged with Accidents Involving Personal Injury, Accidents Involving Personal Injury While Not Licensed, and Reckless Driving.

On October 18, 2016 at 14:13 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Bethlehem Pike at Route 113 for the report of a three vehicle rear end crash. Investigation determined that the striking vehicle was operated by Dante Terrell, 21, from the 400 block of East Ridge Avenue, Sellersville, PA. Investigation further determined that Terrell's driver's license was under suspension. Terrell was charged with Accidents Involving Personal Injury While Not Properly Licensed, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, and Careless Driving.

Theft and Related Offenses

On September 23, 2016 at 14:14 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male and female had entered the store on multiple occasions, selected various retail items from the store shelves and proceeded directly to the customer service desk without paying for the items. The male and female then returned the items as if they were purchased, and receive cash gift cards for the value of the stolen items. The male and female were identified through investigation as Daniel A. Macmillan, 47, and Ellen Macmillan, 48, both residing in the 100 block of Cherry Street, Hatfield, PA. Both Daniel and Ellen Macmillan were charged with Theft by Deception, and Criminal Conspiracy.
