## **Burglary and Criminal Trespass**

On October 29, 2016 at 19:59 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Meadow Glen apartment complex for the report of an unwanted subject who forced entry into a residence thereat. Upon arrival, Police were advised that a subject, known to the resident as Alleem Thomas, 24, no fixed address from Philadelphia, PA, reportedly forced entry into the residence and threatened to punch the occupant in the face and burn down their residence. An arrest warrant for Burglary, Criminal Trespass, Terroristic Threats, and Harassment was obtained for Thomas. He was later taken into custody on the warrant. Thomas was video arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Regina Armitage and committed to Bucks County Correctional Facility in lieu of posting \$500,000.00, or 10% cash bail.

## **Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Controlled Substance**

On September 26, 2016 at 23:08 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Route 309 and Bethlehem Pike for the report of a single vehicle roll-over crash. The driver was identified as Albert Aaron Houser, 50, from the 8200 block of Milky Way, Zionsville, PA. Houser displayed indications of alcohol impairment and was transported to St. Luke's Hospital located in Bethlehem PA for treatment of his injuries. A search warrant for Houser's blood test results was executed at St. Luke's Hospital. The results of Houser's Blood test revealed a 0.239% BAC. Houser was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Careless Driving, and Restrictions on Limited Access Highways.

On October 22, 2016 at 01:21 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a suspicious vehicle on Bethlehem Pike near Cherry Lane. The vehicle operator was identified as Mindy Marie Gallagher, 27, from the 100 block of Wingate Court, Blue Bell, PA. Gallagher displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Gallagher was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.197% BAC. Gallagher was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

## **Narcotics Offenses**

On June 16, 2016 at 21:42 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the area of Keystone Drive and Fairhill Road for the report of a suspicious occupied vehicle. Responding Officers observed a hand to hand drug transaction taking place between two male subjects. The subjects were identified as James Robert Mastromatto, 32, from the 600 block of Fairhill Road, Hatfield, PA, and Daniel Kohl, 37, from the 100 block of Elm Street, Sellersville, PA. Mastromatto was charged with Delivery of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Controlled Substance, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Kohl was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance.
