PRESS RELEASE FOR MARCH 17, 2017

False Identification to Law Enforcement

On February 22, 2017 at 11:31 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Wawa, 3520 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron had entered and exited the store on four occasions within a short period of time, each time carrying a retail item out of the store without paying for it and placing the item in a white van. The white van and female were subsequently located a short distance away in another store. When the female was approached by an officer, she provided a false name and date of birth. The subject was eventually identified as Allisha Davenya Smiley, 21, from the 400 block of West Mt. Pleasant Avenue, Philadelphia, PA. Smiley was charged with False Identification to Law Enforcement, and Retail Theft.

Theft and Related Offenses

On February 23, 2017 at 10:45 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male patron identified as Alexander Jameson Kimmerly, 29, from the 1100 block of Park Avenue, Lansdale, PA had taken numerous electronic items from their packaging, concealed the items within his pockets and past all points of retail sales without paying for the items. Kimmerly was charged with Misdemeanor Retail theft.

On February 17, 2017, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined a male patron had concealed numerous containers of Similac baby formula within a shopping bag. This patron further concealed numerous other cans of Similac within a backpack. When the patron was subsequently confronted by store personnel, he dropped the bag containing the Similac and fled the store with the backpack which still contained numerous Similac containers. The patron was identified as Kurt Holloway, 28, from Orange, New Jersey. Holloway was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft and Receiving Stolen Property.

On February 10, 2017, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a male patron had entered the store on three different days taking numerous cans of Similac baby formula, two televisions, and various other retail items totaling nearly \$1,500.00. The male patron was identified as Eric Joseph Jenkins, 25, from the 3300 block of I Street, Philadelphia, PA. Jenkins was charged with Felony Retail Theft, and Receiving Stolen Property.

Possession of Controlled Substance

In October 2016, Hilltown Police responded to a call of a suspicious occupied vehicle parked in the 100 block of Blueberry Court. Upon investigation, the driver was identified as Frankie Joseph Buccafuri, 36, from the 900 block of Blooming Glen Road, Perkasio, PA. While investigating, Police detected controlled substance within the vehicle. The substance was seized and submitted for analysis which confirmed it was a controlled substance. Buccafuri was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance.

On January 14, 2017 at 18:00 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 200 block of Washington Place for a report of loud music and possible drug use. Upon arrival, responding officers immediately detected the presence of controlled substance within the residence. The substance was located, and the owner of the substance identified as Jamie O. Green 23, from the 400 block of South Union Avenue, Lansdown, PA. Green was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance.
