## PRESS RELEASE FOR JUNE 23, 2017

### Theft and Related Offenses

On June 20, 2017 at 02:49 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 for a disturbance in the parking lot. While investigating the disturbance, Police were advised of a female patron who had just exited the store with a shopping cart full of merchandise without paying for the items. The female was stopped and identified as Kristen Liebsch, 40, from the 100 block of Green Street, Souderton, PA. The items were returned and scanned by store personnel showing a value of nearly \$1,200.00. Liebsch physically resisted arrest when being taken into custody for the Retail Theft. Liebsch was video arraigned before MDJ Charles W. Baum for Felony Retail Theft and Resisting Arrest. She was committed to the Bucks County Correctional Facility in lieu of posting 10% of \$10,000.00 bail.

On June 20, 2017 at 1515 hour, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron selected a retail item offered for sale and proceeded directly to the customer service desk without paying for the item and attempted to return the item for a cash return. The return was denied. The patron then past all points of retail sales and attempted to leave the store without paying for the item. The female was stopped and identified as Zakiyyah Nafeesah Staten, 34, from the 1200 block of 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Philadelphia, PA. Staten was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft, Theft By Deception, and Receiving Stolen Property.

On April 3, 2017 at 18:19 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart for a retail theft. Investigation revealed two male patrons had selected a 65" television, past all points of retail sales and left the store without paying for it. On June 22, 2017 at 16:15 hours, Hilltown Police again returned to Walmart for another retail theft involving the same actors involved in the April 3<sup>rd</sup> theft. One of the male actors was identified as Keith Fluck, 36, from the 1300 block of North Broad Street, Lansdale, PA. Fluck was charged with Misdemeanor Retail Theft. The identity of the other actor remains unknown.

In October 2016, Hilltown Police began a fraud investigation involving an elderly Hilltown couple being scammed of their savings. Investigation determined that a subject, identified as Darryk Gunnar Reynolds, 23, from the 800 block of Allentown Road, Telford, PA, had scammed the couple out of thousands of dollars, between October 2016 and February 2017, by falsely claiming to need the money for various medical treatments and procedures. The claims of the medical treatments were proven false. Reynolds was charged with Theft by Deception, and Receiving Stolen Property.
