PRESS RELEASE FOR MARCH 22, 2018

Possession of Controlled Substance

On February 27, 2018 at 23:22 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 309 near Bergey Road for a speeding violation. The operator was identified as Raven Stephenie Lundy, 21, from the 1100 block of West Airy Street, Norristown, PA. During the stop, controlled substance was detected, and subsequently seized from within the vehicle. The substance was submitted for laboratory analysis. Lundy was charged with Possession of Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, Required Financial Responsibility, Maximum Speed Limits, and Operation of Vehicle Following Suspension of Registration.

On January 27, 2018 at 00:47 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 700 block of Route 113 for the report of a disturbance. The actor was located and subsequently identified as Darien Andrew Palmore, 21, from the 700 block of Route 113, Souderton, PA. Controlled substance was located in close proximity to Palmore. Palmore was charged with Possession of Controlled Substance, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On January 25, 2018 at 16:14 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 700 block of Route 113 for the report of a suspicious vehicle. The vehicle was located and the occupants were identified as Anthony Paul Karns, 33, from the 100 block of North 4th Street, Telford, PA, and Miquel Francis Gonzalez, 21, from the 100 block of West Hamlin Avenue, Telford, PA. Both Gonzalez and Karns were charged with Possession of Controlled Substance.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Controlled Substance

On January 29, 2018 at 21:09 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 113 at Keystone Drive for high speed erratic driving. The operator was identified as Sarah Elizabeth Urso, 36, from the 100 block of Hampshire Drive, Sellersville, PA. Urso displayed indications of alcohol impairment. Urso was taken into custody and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.118% BAC in addition to the presence of controlled substance. Urso was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Registration and Certificate of Title Required, and Driving Vehicle as Safe Speed.

On February 14, 2018 at 14:35 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Route 309 and Route 113 for the report of a vehicle striking a guardrail. Police located the vehicle and identified the operator as Bradley Patrick Caglia, 29, from the 700 block of Green Street, Bridgeport, PA. Caglia displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Caglia was placed under arrest and refused to submit to a blood test. A search warrant was obtained and a blood test was performed resulting in a 0.185% BAC. Caglia was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On March 11, 2018 at 03:45 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle in the 2600 block of Bethlehem Pike for erratic driving. The operator was identified as Elba I. Jusino, 44, from the 2900 block of North Hope Street, Philadelphia, PA. Jusino displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Jusino was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which she refused. Jusino was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Possession of Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Drivers Required to be Licensed.

On March 06, 2018 at 23:26 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 1600 block of Hilltown Pike for a single vehicle traffic accident. The operator had fled the scene but was located a short time later. He was identified as Hector Altamirando Flores, 28, from the 100 block of Maple Avenue, Dublin, PA. Flores displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Flores was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test. Flores was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Property, Careless Driving, and Drivers Required to be Licensed.
