PRESS RELEASE FOR JULY 27, 2018

Possession of Controlled Substance

On July 14, 2018 at 23:31 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 309 near Route 113 for a speeding violation, 82 mph in a 55 mph zone. The operator was identified as Flora Tibilis, 23, from the 700 block of Whistle Stop Lane, Quakertown, PA. Investigation determined that Tibilis was driving under suspension and the vehicle was subsequently impounded. An inventory search of the vehicle revealed the presence of controlled substance. Tibilis was charged with Possession of Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, and Maximum Speed Limits.

On May 27, 2018 at 09:15 hours, Hilltown Police made contact with an individual in the 1200 block of Keystone Drive. This individual was identified as Jason A. Riegel, 42, from the 600 block of Broad Street, Perkasio, PA. Riegel displayed indications of controlled substance impairment. A search of the immediate area surrounding Riegel was conducted resulting in the discovery of suspected controlled substance. Riegel was charged with Possession of Controlled Substance, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On July 17, 2018 at 09:15 hours, Hilltown Police approached a suspicious male subject at Wawa, 752 Route 113, who was seated on the walkway outside of the store. Police identified the male subject as Peter Henry Benjamin Myers, 24, from the 300 block of Erie Avenue, Quakertown, PA. As police were conducted a computer search on Myers, he proceeded inside the Wawa and fled out of the other side of the store. A record check on Myers indicated there was an arrest warrant issued for him out of Huntington County, PA. Myers was located a short distance later and taken into custody. A search of Myers produced controlled substance. Myers was charged with Possession of Controlled Substance, and Flight to Avoid Apprehension.

Theft and Related Offenses

On July 21, 2018 at 14:03 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for a retail theft. Investigation determined that a female patron had taken nearly \$550.00 in assorted grocery items, placed them in a cart, and exited the store without paying for the items. The patron was identified as Nicole C. Burch, 30, from the 100 block of Centre Avenue, Norristown, PA. Burch was charged with Retail Theft.

On June 18, 2018, Hilltown Police responded to Wendy's, 752 Route 113, for a reported theft from a patron. Investigation determined that a patron inadvertently left a bag behind after having dinner at the restaurant. The patron called the restaurant and reported leaving their bag behind. The bag was located and turned in to management by an employee, and then returned to the patron. The patron realized that his wallet had been removed from the bag and money had been taken from the wallet. Store surveillance video revealed the employee had removed the wallet from the bag. The employee was identified as Vandell Shaequan Wynn, 38, from the 1300 block of Deer Run Road, Hatfield, PA. Wynn was subsequently interviewed and admitted to the theft. Wynn was charged with Theft of Property Lost, Mislaid, or Delivered by Mistake.

On June 7, 2018, Hilltown Police responded to Giant Food Store, 760 Route 113, for an employee related theft. Investigation determined that a store employee, identified as Wendy Patricia Shultz, 43, from the 100 block of East Broad Street, Telford, PA, had stolen over \$6,400.00 in store merchandise over 9 different occasions between May 8th and June 9th, 2018. Shultz has been charged with Retail Theft.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Controlled Substance

On July 15, 2018 at 02:32 hours, Hilltown Police investigated a stopped suspicious running vehicle in the 4200 block of Bethlehem Pike. The operator was standing outside of the vehicle urinating in a parking lot. The operator was identified as Jeremy Joseph Witiak, 24, from the 100 block of North 2nd Street, Souderton, PA. Witiak displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Witiak was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test. Witiak was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On July 26, 2018 at 04:44 hour, Hilltown Police responded to the intersection of Broad Street and Upper Church Road for the report of a man slumped over the wheel of his running vehicle. The operator was identified as Confesor Serrano, 42, from the 1900 block of Lincoln Street, Hollywood, FL. Serrano displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Serrano was placed under arrest. Serrano refused a blood test and was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Driving While Operating Privilege is Suspended, and Registration and Certificate of Title Required.

On July 7, 2018 at 00:28 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Hilltown Pike at Greenwood Avenue for expired registration. The operator displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. The driver was identified as Joshua A. Shaibley, 32, from the 700 block of North Limekiln Pike, Chalfont, PA. Shaibley was transported for a blood test and subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Operation of Vehicle with Suspended Registration, and Operation of Vehicle without Certificate of Inspection.

On June 16, 2018 at 02:22 hours, Hilltown Police observed a single vehicle traffic accident occur on Hilltown Pike near Green Street. The operator of the vehicle was identified as Stephen Bernard Johnson, 54, from the 600 block of Thornton Court, North Wales, PA. Johnson displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Johnson was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.165% BAC in addition to a controlled substance. Johnson was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance.

On May 29, 2018 at 12:21 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 900 block of Route 113 for the report of an erratically driven vehicle that had impacted and damaged a driveway culvert and drove off. The vehicle was located parked in a private driveway on Thistle Lane. The operator was located inside the vehicle and identified as Elmira A. White, 62, from the 1300 block of Needham Circle, Hatfield, PA. White displayed indications of alcohol impairment, was placed under arrest, and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.24% BAC in addition to numerous controlled substances. White was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, Accidents Involving Damage to Unattended Property, and Possession of Controlled Substance.

On June 30, 2018 at 23:26 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Quarry and Forest Road for the report of a motorcycle in the ditch. Investigation determined that the motorcycle was operated by Timothy Michael Viall, 53, from the 100 block of Moyer Road, Dublin PA. Viall displayed indications of alcohol impairment and failed a series of field sobriety tests. Viall was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test. Viall was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On June 18, 2018 at 00:45 hours, Hilltown Police stopped a vehicle on Route 309 near Unionville Pike for an expired registration. The operator was identified as Natalie Katelyn Basurto, 24, from the 300 block old North Main Street Sellersville, PA. Basurto displayed indications of alcohol impairment and subsequently failed a series of field sobriety tests. Basurto was placed under arrest and transported for a blood test which later revealed a 0.08% BAC in addition to controlled substances. Basurto was been charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Controlled Substance, Operation Following Suspension of Registration, Required Financial Responsibility, and Operation of Vehicle Without Certificate of Inspection.

Assault

On July 10, 2018 at 19:48 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, 1515 Bethlehem Pike, for the report of a disorderly person. Investigation determined that a female, identified as Nydja Alexander, 18, from the 600 block of South Perkasio Road, Perkasio, PA, engaged another female in a verbal argument and then repeatedly punched this female about the head with a closed fist. Alexander was charged with Simple Assault, and Harassment.
