GOT DRUGS?

The Hilltown Township Police Department now has a Prescription Drug Drop Box available to the public located in the lobby of the Municipal Building. People now have a safe alternative to dispose of their unwanted and expired prescription medications in a manner that will keep these dangerous medications out of the hands of children and those who may abuse them. It will also prevent these drugs from polluting the water supply.

The Police Department partnered with the Office of the District Attorney of Bucks County and Upper Bucks Healthy Community Healthy Youth Coalition (Just Community, Inc.) to jointly purchase the Drug Drop Box. In joining in this partnership, these organizations collectively recognize the danger these drugs represent to our youth, community and environment.

Items accepted for collection are: Prescription Medications, Over-The Counter Medications, Vitamins, Drug Samples, Pet Medications, Ointments, Lotions and Liquid Medications in Leak-Proof Containers.

Items excluded from collection are: Needles, Thermometers, Bloody or Infectious Waste, Medications from Businesses or Clinics, Hydrogen Peroxide, Aerosol Cans and Inhalers.

The Prescription Drug Drop Box is available to the public on weekdays during business hours and is completely anonymous.
