

ORDINANCE NO. 60-4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE LITTERING OF
STREETS, WATER COURSES, SEWERS AND PROPERTY
OF OTHER PERSONS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN

BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted and ordained
by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County
of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1.

No person shall place in any of the streets, creeks,
watercourses or sewer inlets of the Township any excrement, filth,
garbage, ashes, refuse, waste paper, rubbish, animal carcass,
empty boxes or containers, or abandoned matter of any kind.

SECTION 2.

No person shall place or dump any excrement, filth, garb-
age, ashes, refuse, waste paper, rubbish, animal carcass, empty
boxes or containers, or abandoned matter of any kind upon the
premises of any other person within the Township without the
prior permission of such other person.

SECTION 3.

Nothing in this ordinance shall prohibit any person from
setting out garbage or rubbish for collection by the Township or
other authorized collector.

SECTION 4.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance -
shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$300.00 which shall be

collected by summary proceedings brought in the name of the Township before any Justice of the Peace. In default of the payment of said fine and costs, such person may be sentenced and committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
