

NOTICE is hereby given that the following ordinance will be considered for adoption by the Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township at its regular meeting to be held on Saturday, April 16, 1966 at 9:00 o'clock A.M., at the Hilltown Township Building situate on Route 113 west of Silverdale.

Ordinance No. 66-1 amending the Hilltown Township Zoning Ordinance of 1959 by defining the term "junk yard".

IT IS HEREBY enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 103 of the Hilltown Township Zoning Ordinance of 1959 is hereby amended by adding to said section 103 a new subsection to be known as subsection 11.5, reading as follows:

11.5. Junk Yard. Any place where waste, scrap or refuse is stored or accumulated other than as strictly incidental and accessory to a permitted use. Any premises, other than a public garage as herein defined, on which shall be kept in the open two or more unlicensed and inoperable motor vehicles shall be deemed a junk yard.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
