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ORDINANCE NO. 2007-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN HEREBY ORDAINS:

Chapter 153

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

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HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown as indicated in article histories. [Amendments noted where applicable.]

GENERAL REFERENCES

ARTICLE I
General Regulations; Violations and Penalties
of
Chapter 153 Provisions

§153-1. Definitions and interpretation.

- A. Words and phrases, when used in this article, except for sections to which different or additional definitions apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 101 et seq. (the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended, except that in this article the word “street” may be used interchangeably with the word “highway” and shall have the same meaning as the word “highway” as defined in the Vehicle Code.
- B. The term “legal holidays”, as used in this article, shall mean and include New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
- C. In this article, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall include the feminine.

§153-2. Manner of adopting permanent traffic and parking regulations.

All traffic and parking regulations of a permanent nature shall be enacted as ordinances or as parts of ordinances or as amendments to ordinances of the Township of Hilltown and incorporated herein.

§153-3. Temporary and emergency regulations.

- A. The Hilltown Township Chief of Police shall have the following powers to regulate traffic and parking temporarily and in time of emergency.
 - (1) In the case of fire, flood, storm or other emergency, to establish temporary traffic and/or parking regulations.
 - (2) In the case of emergency public works or public events of limited scope or duration, to restrict or prohibit traffic and/or parking in limited areas for periods of not more than 72 hours.
- B. These temporary and emergency regulations shall be enforced by the Hilltown Township Police Department in the same manner as permanent regulations. Any person who drives or parks a vehicle in violation of any such regulation or who shall move, remove, destroy, injure or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made to give notice of any such regulation shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to the penalty set forth in the law or elsewhere in this article for a violation of such nature.

§153-4. Experimental regulations.

- A. The Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township may, from time to time, designate places upon and along the streets in the municipality where, for a period of not more than 90 days, specific traffic and/or parking regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be in force and effect and shall designate those locations by proper signs and markings. Such regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be effective just as if they had been specified in this article. No person shall drive or park a vehicle in violation of any such regulation, prohibition or restriction, and no person shall move, remove, destroy or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made by authority of this section. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be liable to the penalty set out in the law or elsewhere in this article for a violation of such nature.
- B. The purpose of this section is to allow for test and experimental determination of the feasibility and desirability of permanent changes in the ordinances of the Township of Hilltown relative to traffic and parking.

§153-5. Streets closed or restricted for construction, maintenance or special events.

- A. The Hilltown Township Chief of Police shall have authority to close any street or specific part of a street to vehicular traffic and to place barriers or station police officers at each end of the closed portion, while construction or maintenance work is under way or a special event is being conducted on the closed portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such closed portion.
- B. The Hilltown Township Chief of Police shall have authority to establish a restricted traffic area upon any street where construction or maintenance work is under way and to station flagmen at each end of the restricted portion. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle upon any such restricted traffic area at any time when the flagman is displaying a sign directing that vehicle to stop or is signaling that vehicle, by a flag or other device, not to proceed.

§153-6. Authority of police officers.

The police shall have authority to direct traffic on the streets in the Township of Hilltown, at intersections in public and in other places where the Vehicle Code or this article applies.

§153-7. Violations and Penalties.

Any person violating regulations as set forth within Chapter 153 hereof shall be prosecuted under the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code (PMVC), and shall be subject to the fines and penalties therein set forth.

ARTICLE II
Snow and Ice Emergencies
[Adopted 10-30-2000 by Ord. No. 2000-10]

§153-8. Definitions.

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated, unless a different meaning clearing appears from the context:

CARTWAY - Portion of a street or highway improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic, exclusive of the berm or shoulder.

STREET or HIGHWAY - The entire width between the boundary lines of a way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.

§153-9. Declaration of snow and ice emergency.

In order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named in §153-11 hereof, the Hilltown Township Manager, or the Chief of Police in the Manager's absence, in his discretion, may declare a snow and ice emergency (designated in this article as a "snow emergency"). Information on the existence of a snow emergency shall be given by Hilltown Township through radio, newspaper or other available media, and information on the termination of the snow emergency may be given by use of the same media.

§153-10. Parking prohibitions and driving restrictions.

After any snow emergency is declared, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the continuance of the snow emergency, for any person:

- A. To park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any snow emergency route designated in §153-11 of this article; or
- B. To drive any motor vehicle on any such snow emergency route, unless that vehicle is equipped with all-wheel drive, four-wheel drive, front-wheel drive, snow tires, chains or all-weather tires.
- C. The Police Department shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this Article II; and the authority to remove, or cause to remove, any vehicle found to be in violation hereof, if deemed necessary for the health, safety and welfare of Hilltown Township.

ARTICLE III

Traffic Regulations

§153-13. Speed Limits Established.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 153, the speed limit for both directions of traffic along the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule 2 is hereby established at the rate of speed indicated in said Schedule. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that street or part of street.

§153-14. Traffic Control Signals.

Traffic control signals shall be installed and operated (or are ratified if previously installed) at the intersection of those streets described in Schedule 3 attached to and made a part of this Chapter.

§153-15. One-Way Streets.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule 4 attached to and made a part of this Chapter, are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated; and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any one-way street other than in the direction established for traffic on that street.

§153-16. Do Not Enter Streets.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule 5 attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter are hereby designated as Do Not Enter Streets, the entry of which shall be restricted; and as such Do Not Enter signs shall be properly erected and maintained in accordance with applicable PennDOT regulations.

§153-17. Vehicle Weight Limits.

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any commercial vehicle or other tractor, trailer or tractor-trailer combination, having a gross weight in excess of that respectfully prescribed, upon any of the streets or bridges, or portions thereof, described in Schedule 6 attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter, except for the purpose of making local deliveries on said streets.

§153-18. Parking Prohibitions.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule 7, attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter.

§153-19. Stop Intersections.

The intersections described in Schedule 8, attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter are hereby established as Stop Intersections; and official stop signs shall be

§153-11. Snow emergency routes designated.

The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule 1 attached to and made a part of this Chapter, are hereby designated as Snow Emergency Routes.

§153-12. Violations and penalties.

- A. If at any time during a period of snow emergency declared under §153-9 of this article, a person shall park a motor vehicle or allow a motor vehicle to remain parked anywhere upon a snow emergency route, that person shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding brought before a District Justice under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, plus costs of prosecution. In default of payment thereof, the defendant may be sentenced to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days. Each day or portion thereof that such violation continues or is permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense, and each section of this article that is violated shall also constitute a separate offense.

- B. If, at any time during a period of snow emergency declared under §153-9 of this article, a person shall drive a motor vehicle upon a snow emergency route, without having that vehicle equipped with all-wheel drive, four-wheel drive, front-wheel drive, snow tires, chains or all-weather tires, that person shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding brought before a District Justice under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, plus costs of prosecution. In default of payment thereof, the defendant may be sentenced to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days. Each day or portion thereof that such violation continues or is permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense, and each section of this article that is violated shall also constitute a separate offense.

erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position upon the first-named street as to face traffic approaching the second-named street in the direction or directions indicated in said Schedule. Every driver of a vehicle approaching any such intersection upon the first-named street, in the direction or directions indicated in each case, shall come to a full stop before entering any such intersection.

§153-20. Left Turns Prohibited.

No person shall make a left turn at the intersections listed within Section 9 attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter.

§153-21. Stop Except Right Turn Intersections.

The described intersections listed within Schedule 10 are hereby established as Stop Except Right Turn Intersections; and, as such, both “Stop” and “Except Right Turn” signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected).

§153-22. No-Passing Zones.

No-Passing Zones are hereby established along those streets or parts of streets described in Schedule 11, attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter, and it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to overtake or pass another vehicle or to drive on the left side of the roadway in any No-Passing Zone described in said schedule.

§153-23. Fire Lane Parking Prohibitions.

Fire lane parking is hereby prohibited or restricted in the locations described in Schedule 12, attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter, and as such the appropriate Fire Lane/No Parking signs and any other applicable signage and markings shall be erected and maintained as indicated in said Schedule 12 in accordance with applicable PennDOT regulations.

§153-24. Handicapped Parking Prohibitions.

Handicapped parking in designated spaces or areas is hereby prohibited or restricted in the locations described in Schedule 13, and as such the appropriate handicapped parking signs and any other applicable signage and markings shall be erected and maintained as indicated in said Schedule 13 in accordance with applicable PennDOT regulations.

§153-25. School Zones.

School Zones are hereby established for the portions of the streets indicated in Schedule 14, and as such the appropriate traffic control signals and devices, etc. shall be erected, operated and maintained in accordance with applicable PennDOT regulations.

§153-26. Truck Traffic Prohibited.

Truck traffic, commercial vehicles or other trucks, truck tractors, trailers or combinations, or vehicles in excess of the posted weight restrictions, is prohibited from the streets, or sections thereof, indicated in Schedule 15, except local deliveries, and as such the appropriate trucks prohibited signs and any applicable weight restriction signs, if any, shall be erected and maintained as indicated in said Schedule 15 in accordance with applicable PennDOT regulations.

§153-27. Time Limit Parking.

No person shall park a vehicle or allow the same to remain parked on any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule 16, attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter, between the hours specified for longer than the time indicated in said Schedule.

§153-28. Brake Retarder (Jake Brake) Restrictions.

The use of engine brake retarders, otherwise known as jake brakes, on vehicles so equipped are hereby prohibited from use on the streets, or parts thereof, indicated in Schedule 17 of this Chapter.

§153-29. Impounded Vehicles; Applicability and Scope.

This article is enacted under authority of Section 6109(a)(22) of the Vehicle Code and gives authority to the Township to remove and impound vehicles that are parked overtime on any street in the Township in violation of any provision of Articles I, II and III of this Chapter.

§153-30. Authority to Remove and Impound.

The Township shall have authority to remove and impound, or to order the removal and impounding, of any vehicle parked overtime or otherwise illegally, provided that the circumstances of its parking were within the conditions stated in §153-29 of this article and provided that no such vehicle shall be removed or impounded except in strict adherence to the provisions of this article.

§153-31. Designation of approved storage garages; bonding; towing and storage.

Removal and impounding of vehicles under this article shall be done only by one of the Township's Authorized Towing Contractors as designated periodically by the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Resolution #2006-24, or any subsequent version thereof. The Authorized Towing Contractor must operate in accordance with all regulations established in the applicable Resolution, including, but not limited to, liability insurance coverage, fee schedules, storage and the like.

§153-32. Notification of removal and impounding.

Within 12 hours from the time of removal of any vehicle under authority granted by this article, notice of the fact that the vehicle was removed shall be sent by the Township to the owner of record of the vehicle. The notice shall designate the place from which the vehicle was removed, the reason for its removal and impounding and the garage in which it was impounded.

§153-33. Effect of payment of towing and storage charges.

The payment of any towing and storage charges authorized by this article shall, unless payment is made under protest, be final and conclusive and shall constitute a waiver of any right to recover the money so paid. If payment of any towing or storage charges is made under protest, the offender shall be entitled to a hearing before a District Justice. Payment of towing and storage charges shall not relieve the owner or driver of any vehicle from liability for any fine or penalty for the violation of the provision of this chapter for which the vehicle was removed or impounded.

§153-34. Records of vehicles removed and impounded.

The Township shall cause a record to be kept of all vehicles impounded under this article and shall be able at all reasonable times to furnish the owners or the agents of the owners of those vehicles with information as to the place of storage of the vehicle.

§153-35. Restrictions upon removal of vehicles.

No vehicle shall be removed under the authority of this article if, at the time of the intended removal, the owner or the person for the time being in charge of the vehicle is present and expresses a willingness and intention to remove the vehicle immediately.

Schedule 1: SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-11, SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES, all Township roads and streets owned and maintained by the Township, in both directions and the entire length unless otherwise noted, or parts thereof, are delineated as snow emergency routes; and as such, during declared snow emergencies, no vehicle shall be parked on any such street; nor shall anyone operate a vehicle upon any such street unless the vehicle is equipped with all-wheel drive, four-wheel drive, front-wheel drive, snow tires, chains or all-weather tires; and appropriate snow emergency signs shall be erected and maintained in accordance with applicable PennDOT regulations.

(Accidental omissions of posting shall not affect the legality of the omitted posting or the authority to enforce any such omitted posting. Upon dedication of any proposed street or road to Hilltown Township with acceptance thereof by the Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township shall automatically update and include said dedicated street or road as a snow emergency route herein.)

Schedule 2: SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-13, SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED, the following maximum speed limits are hereby established for both directions and the entire length, unless otherwise noted, of the following streets, or parts thereof, and as such the appropriate maximum speed limit signs shall be erected and maintained as indicated below in accordance with applicable Penn DOT regulations:




