## ORDINANCE NO. 2000 - 10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY, DECLARATION OF SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY, PROHIBITION OF PARKING AND RESTRICTION OF DRIVING MOTOR VEHICLES ON SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES DURING EMERGENCIES; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

## THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN HEREBY ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated, unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context:

CARTWAY - Portion of a street or highway improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel, exclusive of the berm or shoulder.

STREET or HIGHWAY - The entire width between the boundary lines of a way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY. In order to facilitate the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named in Section 4 hereof, the Hilltown Township Manager, in his discretion, may declare a snow and ice emergency (designated in this Ordinance as a "Snow Emergency"). Information on the existence of a Snow Emergency shall be given by Hilltown Township through radio, newspaper or other available media, and information on the termination of the Snow Emergency may be given by use of the same media.

SECTION 3. PARKING PROHIBITED, DRIVING MOTOR VEHICLES RESTRICTED, ON SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES DURING SNOW EMERGENCY. After any Snow Emergency is declared, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the continuance of the Snow Emergency, for any person:

A. To park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any Snow Emergency route designated in Section 4 of this Ordinance; or

B. To drive any motor vehicle on any such Snow Emergency route, unless that vehicle is equipped with all wheel drive, four wheel drive, front wheel drive, snow tires, chains or all-weather tires.

## **SECTION 4. SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES DESIGNATED.** The following Hilltown Township roads and streets are designated as Snow Emergency routes:

## **SECTION 5. PENALTIES.**

- A. If, at any time during a period of Snow Emergency declared under Section 2 of this Ordinance, a person shall park a motor vehicle or allow a motor vehicle to remain parked anywhere upon a Snow Emergency route, that person shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance, and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and costs.
- B. If, at any time during a period of Snow Emergency declared under Section 2 of this Ordinance, a person shall drive a motor vehicle upon a Snow Emergency route, without having that vehicle equipped with all wheel drive, four wheel drive, front wheel drive, snow tires, chains or all-weather tires, that person shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance, and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and costs.

**SECTION 6. REPEALER.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following Ordinances or parts thereof are specifically repealed:
