



ORDINANCE #95-10
HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The following Ordinance is hereby adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 60 of 1995, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and

WHEREAS, said act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of 10,000 to 14,999 may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$3,250 per year, and

WHEREAS, the population of Hilltown Township is 10,582, and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act 60 authorizes the board of supervisors subject to the limitations set for in the act,

Now, therefore, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Each supervisor of Hilltown Township elected or appointed to office on or after the effective date of this ordinance shall receive compensation as a supervisor in the annual amount of \$3,250.00.
2. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly installments.
3. This ordinance shall be effective three days after enactment.
