ORDINANCE NO. 93-5

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP LINE ROAD, FROM THE TERMINUS OF ROUTE 152 WESTWARD TO THE TERMINUS OF HILLTOWN PIKE.

THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, upon the recommendation of the Hilltown Township Police Department who has observed the traffic patterns on Township Line Road within Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and pursuant to appropriate engineering and traffic studies and investigation, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

- Section 1. Words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning described to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code "P.M.V.C.", 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act Number 81, as amended. (75 P.S. 1000 et seq., as now enforced of hereafter amended).
- Section 2. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour on Township Line Road in Hilltown Township, from its terminus at Route 152 westward to the intersection of Chalfont Road is hereby prohibited. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of forty-five (45) miles per hour on Township Line Road in Hilltown Township, from its intersection at Chalfont Road westward to its terminus at Hilltown Pike is hereby prohibited.
- Section 3. The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs reducing the speed limits of the aforesaid Township Line Road as set forth herein, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the P.M.V.C.
- Section 4. Any person violating the maximum speed limit as set forth herein shall be prosecuted under the P.M.V.C., and shall be subject to the fines and penalties therein set forth.
- Section 5. All Ordinances, parts of Ordinances, and amendments thereof are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.
- Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
