

ORDINANCE # 85-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP COMMITTING TO AND FOR THE USE OF THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE PENSION FUND CERTAIN MONIES WHICH WERE RECEIVED PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 1985.

The Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Act 205 of 1984, establishing a General Municipal Pension System State Aid Program, hereby adopts the following Ordinance which provides that certain monies distributed to the Township prior to January 1, 1985 be committed solely for the use of the Township's Police Pension Fund.

Section One. All monies received by the Township for the use and/or benefit of the Hilltown Township Police Pension Fund, said receipt occurring prior to January 1, 1985, shall be used only for the benefit and expenses of the Hilltown Township Police Pension Fund. The funds so committed shall remain in accounts which are so titled as to reflect the commitment of funds due the police pension account.
