

ORDINANCE NO. 84-4

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 79-3 WHICH RELATES TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF A REAL ESTATE REGISTRY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. The Supervisors hereby repeal Ordinance 79-3 which was enacted and ordained on the 14th day of May, 1979. Ordinance 79-3 relates to the establishment and maintenance of a real estate registry in the Township of Hilltown. The Ordinance is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.


