

ORDINANCE NO. 82-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 78-9, ENACTED AND ORDAINED NOVEMBER 27, 1978, RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, that the above mentioned Amending Ordinance will be adopted as stated below:

1. Section 1 is amended by adding the following sentence to said section:

Specifically excluded from the definition of truck shall be vehicles which otherwise would be classified as trucks that do not exceed 7,000 pounds in gross weight.

2. Section 2 is amended by adding the following highways to the list of excluded highways:

Conestoga Way

3. Section 4 of Ordinance 78-9 is repealed and the following is substituted in its place:

Section 4 - This Ordinance shall not be applicable to the aforestated highways until such time as a traffic and engineering study has been completed for a particular highway and an official traffic control device giving notice of the traffic regulations of this Ordinance

has been erected upon or at the entrance to the subject highway.

4. Effective Date - This amending Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after it is adopted by the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors
