

ORDINANCE NO. 79.4

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE WEIGHT OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON MILL ROAD BRIDGE OVER AN UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF THE NESHAMINY CREEK, APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET EAST OF RICKERT ROAD IN HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP (T-417 and T-415), AND FAIRHILL SCHOOL ROAD BRIDGE OVER AN UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF THE NESHAMINY CREEK, LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET WEST OF CHURCH ROAD IN HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP (T-332 and LR-09112).

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle or tractor, or tractor or tractor trailer combination, having a gross weight in excess of that herein respectively prescribed, upon any of the following bridges or portions thereof:

<u>Bridge</u>	<u>Portion</u>	<u>Maximum Gross Weight</u>
1) Mill Road Bridge (T-417)(Located over an unnamed tributary of the Neshaminy Creek, approximately 300 feet East of Rickert Road)(T-415)	Entire length of bridge	Ten (10) Tons
2) Fairhill School Road Bridge (T-332)(Located over an unnamed tributary of the Neshaminy Creek, approximately 300 feet West of Church Road) (LR-09112)	Entire length of bridge	Ten (10) Tons

SECTION II. Signs shall be erected and maintained designating the above-stated restrictions at each end of that portion of any highway or bridge restricted as provided in

Section I of this Ordinance and in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. Sections 4903(a, c, and d).

SECTION III. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the powers granted to Townships of the Second Class, particularly those found in 75 Pa.C.S.A. Section 4903, as amended.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following enactment. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. Section 4902(e).


SECTION V. This Ordinance is designed specifically to protect those portions of the Township roadways and bridges which may be seriously damaged by the use or the movement of heavy vehicles. It is further the purpose of this Ordinance to prevent the creation of a safety hazard by the prohibition of the movement of heavy vehicles upon certain roadways and bridges within Hilltown Township.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED this 13th day of August, 1979.


