

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF THE
ORDINANCE ENTERED INTO BY THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF
A PARK INSPECTOR; DESIGNATING THE DUTIES OF
SUCH INSPECTOR; PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION
AND USE OF TRAILERCOACHES AND TRAILERCOACH
PARKS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION
OF THE SAME

Be it Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors
of the Township of Hilltown in the County of Bucks and
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted by
the Authority of the same:

SECTION 1

The Ordinance enacted by the Supervisors of Hilltown
Township, on March 15, 1958, and entitled "An ordinance providing
for the appointment of a park inspector, designating the
duties of such inspector; providing for the regulation and
use of trailercoaches and trailercoach parks and providing
penalties for the violation of the same" is hereby repealed
in its entirety and is made null and void, and without force
and effect.

SECTION 2

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, heretofore
enacted and inconsistent herewith are hereby also repealed
insofar as such inconsistency may exist.

SECTION 3

This ordinance shall become effective five (5)
days after final passage.
