## ORDINANCE NO. 71-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, BY ADDING SECTION 601-1 OF THE ORIGINAL ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County of Bucks, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 601 of the Hilltown Township Subdivision Regulations adopted December 2, 1967, is hereby amended by adding Section 601.1, which reads as follows:

Section 601.1 In the event that a proposed residential subdivision results in the creation of no more than three lots, including the original lot, tract or parcel of land, then and in that event, the Board of Supervisors may modify or adjust the improvements and standards required under this ordinance, including but not limited to street improvements, curbing, and such other modifications as are required to permit reasonable utilization of the property while still permitting subdivision and securing substantial conformance with the objectives of the regulations.
