# HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULARLY SCHEDULED WORKSESSION MEETING Monday, February 11, 2013

The regularly scheduled worksession meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairperson Barbara A. Salvadore at 7:02PM and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

## A. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

#### D. <u>UNFINISHED BUSINESS:</u>

1) <u>Tax Collector Compensation Resolutions</u> – (a) Motion was made by Supervisor McIlhinney, seconded by Supervisor Groff, and carried unanimously to adopt Resolution #2013-10, to set the rate of compensation of the Tax Collector for the years 2014 thru 2017 as noted below:

Year 2014 - Flat rate of \$28,121.40 plus \$4.00 per interim, billed twice per year.

Year 2015 - Flat rate of \$28,683.83 plus \$4.00 per interim, billed twice per year.

Year 2016 - Flat rate of \$29,257.51 plus \$4.00 per interim, billed twice per year.

Year 2017 - Flat rate of \$29,842.66 plus \$4.00 per interim, billed twice per year.

There was no public comment.

(b) Motion was made by Supervisor McIlhinney, seconded by Supervisor Groff, and carried unanimously to adopt Resolution #2013-011 to appoint the Hilltown Township Tax Collector as the individual authorized to provide tax certifications upon request by the public and to authorize said Tax Collector to assess, collect, and retain, as compensation for providing such additional service, a flat fee of \$35.00. There was no public comment.

## E. <u>SUPERVISOR'S COMMENTS:</u>

- 1) Motion was made by Supervisor Groff, seconded by Supervisor McIlhimey, and carried unanimously to authorize Mr. Schnaedter, Solicitor Grabowski, and Chairperson Salvadore to meet with representatives of Haines and Kibblehouse to have all of the questions answered that were brought forth by residents at the February 6<sup>th</sup> Public Forum; and also to answer those questions as previously asked by the Board of Supervisors for their careful consideration prior to rendering any decision on H&K's request to extend the Agreement for the Blooming Glen Quarry.
