1) Planning Commission - Three positions -- Two 4-year terms ending 12/31/16 and One remainder of 4-Year Term until 12/31/14:

- Eric Nogami –Mr. Nogami, a lifetime area resident, is interested in becoming more involved in the community. He is a registered LEED certified architect who has worked in Bucks County, Philadelphia, and the Lehigh Valley. Mr. Nogami is familiar with building codes, zoning regulations and sustainability issues, which he believes would be an asset if chosen to serve on the Planning Commission.

- Barry Casper – Mr. Casper, a 12-year resident, is interested in a public service opportunity, particularly with respect to the future development of the Township. Presently about to begin the last year of his term on the Pennridge School Board, Mr. Casper has been in the insurance business since 1985, and is currently self-employed. Mr. Casper would welcome the challenge of being involved with planning the development of Hilltown Township.

- David Christ, Jr. – Mr. Christ, a 7-year resident of the Township, is the Chief Financial Officer for a vehicle leasing/sales/service company in Colmar. Prior to moving to Hilltown, he served on the Board of Directors of the Rhondda Homeowner's Association in Uwchlan Township, which is a 608-unit planned development located in Chester County. Mr. Christ feels his practical experience previously serving on a nine-member community board would blend well with the responsibilities assigned to the Planning Commission.
