- 1) The Board met in Executive Session prior to this meeting to discuss personnel.
- 2) An advertised Public Hearing will be held at 7:30PM this evening to consider the adoption of an Ordinance amending the Police Pension Plan administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, pursuant to Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law; agreeing to be bound by all provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law as amended and as applicable to member municipalities.

D. SUPERVISOR'S COMMENTS:


