March 3 1941

The Supervisors held their monthly meeting this day with all members present passed and paid the following bills amounting to \$19.24. Receipts were \$515.74. The road tax mileage was made .003 mills. Light Tax for Blooming Glen at .002 mill. A resolution was passed to adopt the proposed budget for 1941 amounting to \$26,672.68 for road purposes and \$274.50 for street lights. The Budget form was sent to Dept. of Internal Affairs, Harrisburg. Fire Ins. Fund tax report was sent to Auditor General, Harrisburg Form 965. Expenditures of State Funds was mailed to Highway Dept. Bids were sent out for stone, to be used for construction of Road 336 for 2700 tons 3A, 700 tons 2 + 400 tons 103 more or less. Bids sent ^{General Crushed Stone Co.} R. H. Kibb, National and Toluckon Quarries Bids to be received by 6 o'clock April 1, said stone to be used on April 8th. The meeting adjourned with \$10,057.55 in treasury. to meet the first Monday in April.
