All bills, labor sheets and vouchers were audited and the balance was \$9848.70 <sup>Pop Funds</sup> which was O.K. by auditors and treasurer. No State Funds on hand at present. Street Right next was audited and found balance in treasury \$117.19. A resolution was passed (to build a tar bound road from Fair Hill north to Route 309 at Hilltop) by unanimous vote. ~~The~~ Because of unfinished business the auditors meeting adjourned to meet at Blooming Glen Hotel on Jan. 15, 1921, to finish audit and prepare statement to report to State Highway Dept at Harrisburg. A letter was sent to Harrisburg requesting permission to erect a traffic light at intersection of Rts 13 & 309, in Hilltown Prop.
