The Supervisors and Auditors of Hilltown met this day with all members present to audit the Tax Collector - Treasurer's account. Mr Arthur Kaul was appointed auditor instead of Mr. Niela Yoder, resigned. The audit was completed and approved by the auditors, Wm W Dill, Fred Fretz and Dill. The 1941 financial report was sent to Harrisburg to Highway Dept. The Supervisors organized the new board, as follows. Pres. Wm R. Yoder Vice Pres. Elmer H. Bright Sec & Treasurer Abram R. Yoder. A resolution was passed to raise the wages for road masters and laborers. Supervisors shall receive 65 cents per hour and laborers 60 cents per hour. said resolution was approved by the Auditors. The tax rate for 1942 was made same as last year. At 003 mills. The Budget was prepared and is ready for and open for inspection to Feb 2 when said budget will be ready for adoption being advertised 8 weeks in The Central news of Perkiom. The Sec was authorized to get the 1941 Financial Report Statements printed and to be posted at public houses in Township. The 1941 Towns Report was made out, notarized and sent to Dept of Revenue. The Blooming Glen Street light acct was audited and approved. by the auditors Total Receipts for 1941 were \$402.49 - Exp \$262.00 and Bal. \$40.58. The Road and paving acct was Total Receipts \$19,272.93. Exp. 19,040.22. Bal. \$10,232.71. The meeting adjourned to meet the first Monday in Feb.
