## HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS BUDGET MEETING DECEMBER 6, 1989

The December 6, 1989 advertised Budget Meeting was called to order by Chairman Robert H. Grunmeier at 7:30 P.M.

Members present were: Robert H. Grunmeier, Chairman Betty J. Kelly, Vice Chairperson William H. Bennett, Supervisor

GENERAL FUND ACCOUNT - EXPENDITURES

01-400-113: Salaries - Supervisors -- Motion was made by Mr. Bennett and seconded by Mrs. Kelly to approve \$8250 for three Supervisors' salaries including semi-annual road inspection; motion carried unanimously.

01-400-115: Auditing Services -- Motion was made by Mrs. Kelly and seconded by Mr. Bennett to approve a maximum \$600 for each auditor (\$1800 total); motion carried unanimously.

01-401-121: Salary Manager -- deferred at this time.

01-401-125: Assistant Township Manager -- deferred.

01-401-120: Office Supplies -- \$5,000 (placed on competitive bid) -- APPROVED.

01-401-260: Office Equipment -- \$2,500 -- Mr. Bennett questioned kind of typewriters (not word processors); Mr. Bennington noted that previous cost of \$41,000 was to stock new township building -- APPROVED.

01-401-265: Equipment Repairs -- \$1,000 -- APPROVED.

01-401-270: Maintenance Agreements -- \$4,000 (new account) -- Approved.

01-401-301: Other Expenses -- \$1,200 -- Mr. Bennington questioned types of expenses -- court costs and related expenses, out-of-town meetings, etc. for Administration and Supervisors -- APPROVED.

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01-406-350: Insurance/Property -- \$60,000 -- deferred.

01-406-352: Liability Insurance (Police Professional and Public Official's Liability Policies) -- \$24,000. Motion was made by Mr. Bennett to lower this amount from \$24,000 to \$21,000; motion seconded by Mrs. Kelly and carried unanimously.

01-407-120: Wages - Consultant (George Bock \$30/hr.) Motion was made by Mr. Bennett to lower amount from \$1,500 to \$500; motion seconded by Mrs. Kelly and carried unanimously.

01-407-200: Equipment (additional computer terminals and wiring) -- Mr. Bennington questioned the need for 5 terminals; Mr. Bennett suggested they be purchased gradually. Motion was made by Mr. Bennett to lower the request from \$3,000 to \$2,000; motion seconded by Mrs. Kelly and carried unanimously.

01-409-240: Waste Disposal (disposal for township building). It was suggested that disposal company empty tank on an "as needed" basis; township would telephone them when required. Motion was made by Mr. Bennett to lower the request from \$4,700 to \$3,000; motion seconded by Mrs. Kelly and carried unanimously.

01-409-367: Trash Collection (for dumpster disposal at Rt. 113 and Diamond Street and 13 W. Creamery Rd.) --\$1,800 -- APPROVED.

01-409-373: Maintenance and Repair (including materials for repairs to old building) -- \$2,000 -- APPROVED.

01-409-731: Equipment (ladders, buffing machine, display cabinet, easels and outside containers). Chairman Grunmeier meeting suggested a water fountain be installed in the main lobby: Mr. Bennington also suggested a clock be ordered for the meeting Chief Egly stated that a clock is being room: supplied. Mr. Bennington also suggested a stage or platform be provided for review of plans in meeting room. Motion was made by Mr. Bennett to lower the request from \$5,000 to \$3,500 including the cost of a water fountain; motion seconded by Mrs. Kelly and carried unanimously.

Mr. Bennington asked that the detective's car and dispatch taping system be omitted; discussion ensued; Mr. Bennington revised his request to include two new cars (one for Det. Leyden and one police vehicle. Motion was made by Mr. Bennett to change the budget request from \$86,000 to \$30,000 to include two new patrol cars (one marked and one unmarked); and to transfer the three other items (dispatch center, scales, and equipment for photo lab), totaling \$50,000, to the Bond Issue request; motion seconded by Mrs. Kelly and carried unanimously.

Mr. Singley remarked that the codification of ordinances will be of help and will eliminate time now necessary to research information.
