Items discussed:

Program Book:

Mrs. Waite reported that 1000 programs will be printed - approximate cost for printing per page is \$45 to \$55. Total ads presently total \$3,609.

Pens and Plates:

Pens and plates have been ordered. Plates will be made in a limited edition run of 500 - all numbered.

Cost of plates was discussed: It was agreed to charge \$10 per plate (cost to the Township is \$6.25 each or \$3,125 total).

Mark Zellar, Zellar's of Cedars, will supply the buffet and hors d'oeuvres. He must be contacted LO days prior to the date with number attending. Cost for 200 persons is \$9.75/person. Buffet will be set up in the meeting room. Chief Egly stated he would contact the Hilltown Fire Company, asking for use of tables and volunteers to set up and dismantle the tables.
