

Hilltown Township Supervisors' Meeting

March 9,,1981

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Vincent Pischl. The treasurer's Report was read by Mrs. Gutekunst and approved by Edward Wentz and seconded by Mary Lockard. Bills in the amount of \$4,554.28 were approved for payment by Ed Wentz and seconded by Mary Lockard.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed with the following comments: Question raised on whether the third quote had been received on electrical inspections. Mr. Wynn reported that he had called Middle-Atlantic and they promised to get their bid in immediately. Mr. Jeff Drake of Charles Wilson's office made a correction in the minutes pertaining to the liability of the township in case a negligent inspection could be proved. Minutes approved with this one correction.

Mr. Wynn reported that the bids have been advertised for the Reliance Road project and they will be opened at the March 23rd meeting. Also, Mrs. Gutekunst had received a letter from Community Development to advertise for engineer's credentials for the 1981 Hud project, Central Avenue Bridge. These bids should be coming in to be opened on March 23rd. Also the bids for stone, oil, etc will be coming in for opening on March 23rd.

A letter was received from Mr. Wynn of Cowan Associates advising us that final plans and specifications for the Orchard Road Bridge construction have been completed. The county has received all necessary approvals and funding. Currently, the project is at the property acquisition stage and has been for some time.

Mr. Drake reported that we will have to adopt an ordinance for Flood Plain Regulations which his office will prepare.

Letter of 2-25-81 concerning the UHF Police Radio System was briefly discussed. However, since Chief Boose was not at the meeting, Mr. Pischl will consult with him before we reply- deadline for reply being April 15, 1981.

Mrs. Gutekunst read Mr. Hoot's February report- fees collected-\$1046.00 permits issued for two new houses.

Mrs. Gutekunst is to write a letter to Hatfield Township with a copy to PennDot of having a delayed green signal at the intersection of Unionville Pike and Route 309.

Mr. Ed Aichele asked about the possibility of zoning ordinances' violations on the Kendra property located at Rickert Road- five buildings on property- repairs scales; on the Largeant Farm- on Green Street between Rickert and Mill- selling meats; Hardy on Diamond St.- machine shop; and Hewitt- paver- trucks and junk. Also mentioned Bevans and Mr. Wentz told him that we are in litigation on that one.

Meeting was adjourned as Mr. Aichele had a heart attack and Dr. Buttram, Dublin ambulance crew and Paramedics from Doylestown responded to the calls.
