## MINUTES

The meeting of the Supervisors of Hilltown Township was held this 3rd day of May 1973 at 7:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Frankenfield, with all Supervisors present.

The meeting was opened with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, held April 21, 1973. The minutes were approved as read on a motion by Mr. Hartshorne and seconded by Mr. Frankenfield.

The bills were reviewed and ordered paid on a motion by Mr. Hartshorne and seconded by Mr. Frankenfield, for the amount of \$ 4,353.63.

A phone call from Mr. George Spotts, of the Bucks County Planning Commission requesting we name a date and place where we could meet with them, either their office or ours would be convenient.

A bid was received from Loder & Sharp Inc., for our Chipper, 1120 Bethlehem Pike, Flourtown, Pa. for the amount of \$3.959.00. A motion by Mr. Frankenfield and seconded by Mr. Hartshorne, accepted this bid.

The Supervisors signed the final subdivision plan for Gwendolyn Glick, Keystone Drive, one lot; final subdivision plan for Orville Liverman, Highland Park Rd., two lots; final subdivision plan for Lydia Alexander, Blueschool Rd., two lots; Charles Brown, final subdivision plan, two lots.

The Secretary is to inquire of Mr. Rittenhouse, plumber, if he would give a service contract or assurance to look after burner service; on May 9, 1973, Mr. C. M. Rittenhouse stated he does not make any contract for service, bur recommends the heater should be cleaned at the start of the heating season, and if service is needed, he would be on call, at 536–6074.

The Supervisors agreed to purchase the above extinguishers.

We received a letter dated April 26, 1973, from our Solicitor, Smith & Wilson, under signature of Victor Jaczun, informing us that a motion to dismiss appeal in the Supreme Court of the United States October term 1972, No. A22, Hilltown Township Appelee, Charles J. Mager and his wife Hazel D. Mager, Appellant, on appeal from the Supreme Court of Pa., a motion by Hilltown Township to dismiss appeal.

The Supervisors are going to meet with the Bucks County Planners for a date not as yet determined.

Mr. Hartshorne suggested we have a moratorium on awyrezoning, our Solicitor stated that legally we cannot do this.

A petition has been filed by J. Raymond & Charity Hillegas for a rezoning change from LI to Multi Family, located on Township Line Road and Reliance Road.

At about this time the lights went out, with the use of flashlights, candles and a lantern, we continued our meeting.





Monday, April 30, 1973, at a meeting at the Moose Building, 113 and Broad St., Quakertown, Pa., with the Home Rule Study Commission, Mr. Frankenfield, Mr. Hartshorne, and Mr. Moyer were present with only one member of the Home Rule Study Commission who appeared. After waiting a period of forty-five minutes, the Supervisors agreed to leave, only to learn that the meeting was changed to the High School.
