

FRETZ REZONING HEARING

A meeting of the Hilltown Township Supervisors was held this 12th day of April to hear the petition of J. Richard Fretz and Elizabeth, for rezoning a tract of land located on Hilltown Pike, Keystone Drive and Mill Road.
