

SPECIAL MEETING

The Hilltown Township Supervisors met this January 11, 1973, at the Municipal Building, Blooming Glen, Pa.

In attendance were Mr. Frankenfield, Mr. Hartshorne, Mr. Moyer, Mr. Cowan and Mr. Ehrlinger.

The Supervisors requested Mr. Cowan to give his rates to be charges for the submission of subdivision plans.

The Supervisors discussed whether we could have developers post a bond for the maintenance of the roads after final disbursement, for a period of one (1) year after completion.

Mr. Frankenfield questioned Mr. Cowan if we would need guard rails along Reliance Rd., where the new bridge has been erected.

Mr. Hartshorne wanted to know if the In-Depth Study was included in the amount needed for funding.

Mr. Cowan stated that the laterals should be along the roads, so we would lose any Federal Funding for Collector Lines.

Application costs for funding and photos, Hilltown's costs would be \$9100 and Silverdale's costs would be \$4800.

The Supervisors signed the Expenditures Report to be mailed to Wm. Fell, Dept of Transportation, Doylestown, Pa. and the approved resolution for applications for permit to erect and maintain traffic lights.

The meeting adjourned at 5:45 P.M.
