The Supr of Hilltown held their semi-monthly meeting this day with two members present. Mr Agin was absent. The foregoing bills were passed & paid amounting to \$2848.98. Receipts amounted to \$1397.43. Bal in the Treasury at close of meeting was \$17210.41 in Gen Fund and 2040.88 in S.F. or a total amount in Treasury of \$19261.39. A Taxpayer on Green Str was present to inquire about erecting snow fence along his property. A Mr Norton a Representative of a large building firm was present to inquire about changing a part or whole of 302 from Residential zoning to Commercial, and was requested to see Mr Ed Rehnke or Mr Lloyd Yoder, Sec and president of the Zoning Planning Com and find out how much time was needed to make such change in zoning. Mr Youell was present to inquire about approval of plans for Mr John Cronin's Trailer Camp. Two new Ordinances, after being duly advertised in The News-Head were adopted this day and read as follows: No 1 An Ordinance Prohibiting the littering of streets, water courses, ditches, and property of other persons in Hilltown Township. No 2 Defining disorderly practices and providing penalties for the violation thereof. The Supervisors decided to hold the 1960 Annual meeting on Dec 31, 1960, and the Auditors meeting on Jan 7, 1961, at Twp Q office at 9 A.M. The meeting adjourned to meet on Dec 17th at 9 A.M.
