A letter was read from our Solicitor, to consider reducing the density units in a Multi-Family area. We will consider this at our January meeting, 1973.

Mr. Hartshorne, the Supervisor's pepresentative on the Advisory
Board of Today Inc., informed us that the residents of the home have
been moved to the home in Newtown, and this home in Hilltown will be
used as a Half*Way House. He also stated there was a need for a
vacuum cleaner and an automobile. The drive way needs attention, and
Mr. Frankenfield will check and see what is needed to improve the driveway.

The Supervisors wish to thank the Deep Run Jaycees for the nice painting job that they did in the gym building.

Mr. Frank Meld, a member of the Deep Run Jaycees, requested permission of the Supervisors if they could have cinders to place in barrels along the highways, permission granted.

The budget was again discussed and if we would reduce themmillage or leave as proposed, was discussed. The Supervisors are to meet December 21, 1972, when the final decision will be made.

There being no further business, Mr. Frankenfield made a motion for adjournment, and Mr. Hartshorne made the motion and Mr. Frankenfield seconded it. The meeting adjourned at 11:00 A.M.
